

## (12) WHAT THE SETTING DOES WELL

- 1. There was a very warm, caring and friendly atmosphere in the setting, where children felt affirmed, valued, and respected.
- 2. The early childhood setting fostered an inclusive learning environment that supported the participation of all children. Staff demonstrated a strong understanding of individual differences, thoughtfully adapting to the varying styles, paces, and focuses of each child's learning and development.
- 3. Teachers planned engaging, high-quality learning experiences, resulting in children displaying high levels of enjoyment, engagement, and motivation in their learning.
- 4. Links with parents and the community were judged to be excellent. The setting maintained strong connections with the local community, demonstrated by its active participation in a variety of organised events that engage both the pre-school and children's families.



- 1. Further strengthen assessment systems by aligning the focus areas of the Cayman Islands Curriculum Framework with the four universal domains of the OES Early Childhood Inspection Framework, to enhance the tracking and reporting of children's learning and development.
- Enhance self-evaluation and improvement planning processes by maintaining a clear focus on measurable outcomes to drive meaningful progress, and by using high-impact, precise language in school improvement planning documents.
